Grant Application Quarterly Deadline Dates: January 1, April 1, June 1, October 1

Clinical Practice Project in Memory of Linda Knauff - up to \$2,000

Qualifications: Principal investigator must be a member of Minnesota Nurses Association (MNA) or an Associate Member of Minnesota Nurses Association and be engaged in direct patient care, completion within 2 years of funding date, periodic reports on project progress and budget.

MNA ASSOCIATE MEMBER SCHOLARSHIPS DEADLINE JUNE 1 OF EACH YEAR

Criteria for all scholarships:

- Must be an Associate Member of Minnesota Nurses Association (MNA). **To become an associate member contact MNA at 1-800-536-4662, 651-414-2800 or mnnurses@mnnurses.org.**
- Must have attended at least one MNA event such as Student Nurses Day on the Hill, MNA Education Session, Ethics Book Club, etc.
- GPA must be 3.0 or higher.
- Must be enrolled in a nationally accepted nursing program.
- Additional criteria for specific scholarship listed below.

BACCALAUREATE OR MASTERS OR HIGHER	<input type="checkbox"/> Cynthia Hunt-Lines (\$5,000) Must be single parent of at least one child (include ages of dependent children).
	<input type="checkbox"/> Sarah Colvin Social Justice (\$2,000) Must document evidence of advocating for individuals and groups harmed by inequities, environmental exploitation, discrimination, and oppression. Examples of social justice issues may include, but are not limited to, working with the mentally ill, impoverished, abused, or elderly

You may apply for one scholarship per year. An applicant is eligible to receive a maximum of two MNAF scholarships as an undergraduate student, and two scholarships as a graduate student.
