Management: NO NEW CONTRACT LANGUAGE—PERIOD!



Nearly 100 nurses from Methodist came and stood in solidarity at open bargaining today. While this was a great show of nurse power, it wasn't enough to stop management from uttering their favorite phrase again: NO NEW CONTRACT LANGUAGE!

Though the Hospital did give us counterproposals on Workplace Violence and Designated Resource Nurses, these offers were disappointing. That said, management continues to state that they don't see "how any of the issues that the nurses have proposed (and deeply care about) would be addressed by putting it in the contract."

THE TIME IS NOW! NURSES WILL NEED TO PUT MORE PRESSURE ON METHODIST HOSPITAL IF YOU WANT A CONTRACT THAT GIVES YOU THE DIGNITY, RESPECT, AND SAFETY YOU AND YOUR PATIENTS DESERVE!
