Dear Ronda:

As the Union stated in our letter of May 16 (Amended on May 17), we anticipated the possibility of needing more than one bargaining session prior to the expiration of the agreement to resolve all of the outstanding issues between the parties. We offered multiple dates (May 24, 29, 30 and 31) because we thought both sides had a mutual interest in scheduling enough bargaining sessions to come to an agreement prior to expiration-which is after all the goal of good faith negotiations.

Although we made significant progress on non-economic issues at our May 24 session, the lack of substantive responses to the Union's economic concerns during the evening session made it clear that there wasn't a path to an agreement during that session- as we went late into the evening. Therefore, the Union asked which one of the remaining dates (May 29, 30 and 31) Children's would to agree to. Children's declined to answer.

After receiving no answer on the additional dates, the Union followed up yesterday- and received the surprising reply that Children's wasn't available due to scheduling issues this week. It is very difficult for the Union to understand this given that we had offered up multiple dates well in advance.

Given all of the above the Union is available to meet on the following dates next week: June 3, June 4 and June 5.

If we do not make more substantial progress at our next session, and in light of the unfair labor practices committed by Children's as a part of this process, the Union will be forced to schedule a strike vote.

We hope that we can come to a resolution prior to that.
