CRITERIA FOR MNA MEMBER SCHOLARSHIPS

- Must be a member in good standing of Minnesota Nurses Association (MNA).
- GPA must be 3.0 or higher.
- Must be enrolled in or accepted to a nursing program that is accredited by Accreditation Commission for Education in Nursing (ACEN) or Commission on Collegiate Nursing Education (CCNE).

CRITERIA FOR MNA ASSOCIATE MEMBER SCHOLARSHIP

- Must be an associate member in good standing of the Minnesota Nurses Association (MNA).
 MNA will verify associate membership status
- GPA must be 3.0 or higher
- Must be enrolled in or accepted to a nursing program that is accredited by Accreditation Commission for Education in Nursing (ACEN), Commission on Collegiate Nursing Education (CCNE), or National League for Nursing Commission for Nursing Education Accreditation (CNEA)

CRITERIA FOR MARY ELIZA MAHONEY SCHOLARSHIP

- Must be a member of another labor union in good standing pursuing education to become a Registered Nurse.
- Indigenous people and people of color especially encouraged to apply
- Must be enrolled in a nursing program accredited by Accreditation Commission for Education in Nursing (ACEN), Commission on Collegiate Nursing Education (CCNE), or National League for Nursing Commission for Nursing Education Accreditation (CNEA)

CRITERIA FOR MNA 40 & 8 VETERANS SCHOLARSHIP

- Eligible applicants who are not current MNA members in good standing will automatically receive a 2023 MNA associate membership upon MNA's receipt of scholarship application. An associate membership allows members to access certain MNA activities like education or political advocacy
- Have a GPA of 3.0 or higher
- Be enrolled in or accepted to a nursing program that is accredited by Accreditation Commission for Education in Nursing (ACEN) or Commission on Collegiate Nursing Education (CCNE)
- Is serving or has served honorably in any branch of the United States armed forces at any time: or
 - Has served honorably for a total of five credible years or more cumulatively as a member of the National Guard or any other active or reserve component of the United States armed forces, and any part of that service occurred on or after September 11, 2001; or
 - Spouse or child of a person who has served in the military at any time; or
 - If an alum of another service agency, applicant must be able to describe how your service enriched the lives of the people you served

CRITERIA FOR LEGACY SCHOLARSHIP

- Must be a child, grandchild or dependent of a MNA member in good standing
- Must have completed one (1) semester of undergraduate college study
- Open to all majors and degrees
- College GPA must be 2.5 or higher
- Must be enrolled at least part-time in an undergraduate program (at this time, scholarships are not open to graduate study)
- Applicant can apply yearly, however, can only receive scholarship once.
